### Title

- Title: Maximum 100 characters: Font- Times New Roman, 14, bold
- Authors: List all authors, indicating the corresponding author with an asterisk
- Provide email addresses on separate lines. Font: Times New Roman, 12
- · Author affiliations: Font- Times New Roman, 11, Italic
- Keywords: Include up to 5 keywords

## Abstract

- Word Limit: Abstract should not exceed 300 words
- Content: The abstract should encompass a succinct summary of the research, covering objectives, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusions
- Formatting: Font-Times New Roman, 12; Line spacing-1.5

Authors are kindly reminded that abstracts that do not adhere to the aforementioned guidelines will not be considered for acceptance. Further, abstracts are not an extended format.
